I am to state that as per the directions of the Election Commission of India, National Voters' Day is being celebrated across the country on 25th January of every year and the 12th National Voters' Day will be celebrated on 25th January, 2022. The Election Commission of India has also directed that National Voters' Day will be celebrated throughout the State at all levels, i.e., State, District and Polling Station Locations on 25.01.2022 by adhering COVID-19 safety measures vide reference first cited.

2. The Commission has requested to organise the National Voters' Day function, in an online mode in association with various Institutions/ Organisations such as Academic Institutions, Organisation of Youth volunteers like NSS, NCC, Scouts and Guides etc., keeping in view of Covid safety norms. Further National Voters' Day Pledge to be administered to all the people present during an online event and also the pledge to be circulated over Whatsapp groups. The Commission has also stated that various Departments/ Organisations/ bodies may be encouraged to administer National Voters' Day Pledge on the day of National Voters' Day and the same may be uploaded on their Social Media handles/ website using hashtag #NVD2022.

3. I am, therefore, to request you to issue instructions to the Educational Institutions / HoDs under your control to administer the National Voters' Day Pledge at 11.30 A.M on 25.01.2022 either in offline mode or in online mode like Whatsapp group. This will inspire, in the youth, a sense of citizenship, pride and participation in the election process. A copy of the Pledge (both in English and Tamil) is enclosed.
