- 1. I extend my gratitude for the support provided by you and your able team during the Airmen Recruitment Rally. I want to put it on records that the Rally wouldn't have been possible without your support and co-operation and the same has been communicated to the highest echelon in the Indian Air Force. I am elated to share that we could enroll 120 Med Asst / Pharmacist into the IAF from the Rally conducted in Feb 23 by this unit and their training has commenced on 28 Jun 23 at ATS, Belagavi.
- 2. We have the next Agniveervayu intake 01/24 lined up for which the registrations are starting from 27 Jul 23 (1000H) and the online examination would commence from 13 Oct 23. The advertisement for the same has been published in leading Nation newspapers through Dte of Audio visual Publicity (DAVP). A copy of the said advertisement is attached herewith as (Appendix 'A').

candidates for selection test from 13 October 2023 onwards to join the IAF as an AGNIVEERVAYU. The number and employability of female
candidates will be decided as per service requirement.

(THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/ PILOTS/ NAVIGATORS)

- Application is required to be filled only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are available at <a href="https://enripathyayu.cdac.in">https://enripathyayu.cdac.in</a>.
- 3 This examination is valid for AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2024.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION shall commence at 1000h on 27 July 2023 and will close at 2300h on 17 August 2023. Only ONLINE REGISTERED applications shall be accepted. For registration log on to <a href="https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in">https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in</a>.

Note: - Candidates are advised to register at the earliest opportunity as no extension of registration dates will be accommodated.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

# 5. <u>Age</u>.

- (a) Date of Birth Block. Candidate born between 27 June 2003 and 27 December 2006 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- (b) In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be 21 years.
- Marital Status and Pregnancy. Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for errorment as Agriveervayu and they shall undertake not to marry during the defined ergagement period of four years. Keeping in view finited period of ergagement of Agriveervayu inclusive of training, still development activities, practical as well as fermative assessment and coganisational requirement of continued services of Agriveervayu during the engagement period, longer absence of Agriveervayu during the engagement period will adversally effect the operational elificiency of the Indian AF Force. Agriveervayu with period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agriveervayu will be eligible for selection in regular cacke as Airman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such women Agriveervayu on becoming Low Medical Category (J.M.C) due to pregnancy shall be table to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will debat the women Agriveervayu for selection into Regular Cache. At the time of errorment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions\*.

## 7. Educational Qualification

# (a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electrorics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technolo

Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matricutation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

# Other than Science Subjects

Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

    - For Male candidates: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms.

- (g) Comeal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable.
  - Note: Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The latest prescription should contain d measurement, Ophthalmologist's registration number, stamp, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to app for medical examination.
- (h) General Health: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He / She should be free from any active or latent, acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or communicable disease, infection and skin allments. Candidate shall be physically and mentalty FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.
- Gynaecological Examination (For female candidates): The examination covers external genitalia, hernia orifices and the perineum, any ce of stress urinary incontinence or genital prolapse outside introflus.

- (k) Gender (For female candidates): Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on external physical examination, will be rejected as Unfit. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared Unfit.
- (i) Pregnancy (For female candidates): Any candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature rejected.

- Consumption of Narcotic <u>Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS)</u>. Consumption of Narcotic <u>Drugs and Psychotropic substances banned under the NDPS Act 1985 shall be a reject criteria for selection into the LNF. - 10. Body Iattoo. Permanent body taltoos are not permitted, however, taltoos only on inner face of the fire arms (inside of ebow to the wrist), back (forsal) part of the hand/leverse side of the palm and finishs with lattoo which are as per the custom and traditions of their tribes may be considered. # TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 12. Agriveervayu will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agriveervayu would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agriveervayu beyond the engagement period of four years.
- 13. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, Agriveervayu will be offered an opportunity to apply for errolment in the regular cache of the Indian Air Force as Airmen. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criticals, including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific bastor ho flagniveervay will be errolled in regular cache of UEV. Agniveervay will not have any right to be selected for further enrollment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveervayu for further enrollment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Government Cliff.
- Employability. Agriveervayu enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.
- Iraining. On being enrolled, Agniveervayu will be imparted military training based on Indian Air Force requirements.
- Leave. Orant of leave will be subject to exigencies of the Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agnivesryary during their ment period:
  - (a) Annual Leave, 30 days per year
  - Sick Leave. Based on medical advice (b)
- Medical and CSD Facilities. For the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Air Force, Agriveervayu will be entitled for me facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.

Marks sorred by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Testing will be "Normalised" by using the formula as published on the web site <a href="https://zoinjeathwayu.obsc.n.">https://zoinjeathwayu.obsc.n.</a>, to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to note that the application of Cut-Off for shortisting candidates for STAR Phase-I testing and preparation of Final Merit List for selection will be based on "Normalised Marks" and not in the "Actual Marks" scored by the candidate in TSTAR Phase-I testing. Further, on normalisation, marks scored by a candidate in a subject may become less/more than actual marks, and more than total marks of that subject in exceptional cases.

Additional SkillsQualifications/Achievements in feeds, including but not limited b, Information Technology, Motor Vehicle driving / maintenance, Hospitally, Logistics, Accounting, Calering, Welting, Typing Skill, Sports et. are required to uplead supporting certificates / documents through a link provided along with Phase-II call letter and also lumish them at the time of Phase-II lesting. Candidates are encouraged to acquire additional skills to have an edge in their performance during training and subsequent lenure as 'Agniversizing'.
- 28. <u>Verification of Eliqibility</u>. Candidates should be in possession of the documents mentioned at para 26 & 27 above, when appearing for the selection test which would be scrutinised/verified prior to commencement of Phase-II to ascertain the eligibility prima-face.
