**ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2024**

*Dear Sir / Madam,*

1. I extend my gratitude for the support provided by you and your able team during the Airmen Recruitment Rally. I want to put it on records that the Rally wouldn't have been possible without your support and co-operation and the same has been communicated to the highest echelon in the Indian Air Force. I am elated to share that we could enroll 120 Med Asst / Pharmacist into the IAF from the Rally conducted in Feb 23 by this unit and their training has commenced on 28 Jun 23 at ATS, Belagavi.
2. We have the next Agniveervayu intake 01/24 lined up for which the registrations are starting from 27 Jul 23 (1000H) and the online examination would commence from 13 Oct 23. The advertisement for the same has been published in leading Nation newspapers through Dte of Audio visual Publicity (DAVP). A copy of the said advertisement is attached herewith as **(Appendix 'A')**.
3. It was observed that the numbers of registrations were not very encouraging for the last intake and the candidates are not able to clear the phase I online examination. This time it would be our endeavor to work along with your able team to reach maximum youth of your district. A detailed study was conducted by this unit and it is felt that the candidates appearing for online examination will have brighter chances of success with some guidance from their resp college placement cells. The syllabus and sample papers are available on link <https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in>. Also, undersigned along with the ASC team would be more than keen to conduct a large scale motivational / awareness lecture online/offline to motivate the youth to join IAF as Agniveervayu and work with pride for their motherland.
4. It is requested that instructions may please be circulated through your office for widespread publicity for 'Agniveervayu intake 01/24' with the help of all available resources including PRO, Education and Employment officers, district employment sites etc. Listed below are some of the measures which would help in reaching maximum youth across your district:

- (a) The notification / advertisement may be uploaded in the district employment site.
  - (c) Newspaper advertisement may be printed in local dailies and in local news channels / radio channels to reach maximum youth.

Note: Above examination methodology has been designed to facilitate selection process based on qualifications of candidates irrespective of the examination methodology AGNI/VEERVAYU enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.

24. Marks scored by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Test will be 'Normalised' using the formula as published on the web site <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in>, to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to note that the application of Cut-off for shortlisting candidates for STAR Phase II testing and preparation of Final Merit List for selection will be based on 'Normalised Marks' and not on the 'Actual Marks' scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I Test. Further, on normalisation, marks scored by a candidate in a subject may become less than actual marks, and more than total marks of that subject in exceptional cases.

25. CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER INDIVIDUALLY IN SCIENCE SUBJECTS AND OTHER THAN SCIENCE SUBJECTS, with normalised marks. The result of Phase I and the list of shortlisted candidates for Phase II, based on their performance in Phase I (online test), will be uploaded on <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in> within one month from the last date of online exam.

#### Phase - II

26. Soon after the declaration of the result of Phase I (Online) Test, a cut off will be applied based on the normalised marks scored by the candidates in the Phase I Test and SHORTLISTED candidates will be sent a new admit card on their registered e-mail IDs for Phase-II test at a designated ASC. The admit card for Phase-II exam can also be downloaded online under candidate's login on CASB web portal <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in>. Candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase-II at the designated ASC along with following -

- Colour print out of Phase II admit card.
- Colour print out of duly filled application form downloaded on completion of online registration.
- HB pencil, eraser, sharpener, glue stick, stapler and black/Blue ball point pen for writing.
- Eight copies of un-attested passport size colour photograph (which was used for the online application registration).
- Original and four self-attested photocopies of matriculation passing certificate (required for verification of candidate's name, father's name and his/her date of birth).
- Original and four self-attested photocopies of matriculation marks sheet (only applicable for three years' diploma / two years Vocational Course holders when English is not a subject in diploma / Vocational Course).
- Original and four self-attested photocopies of Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent examination passing certificate and marks sheet.

#### OR

Original and four self-attested photocopies of three years diploma course passing certificate and marks sheets of all semesters

#### OR

Original and four self-attested photocopies of two years Vocational course passing certificate and all marks sheets including non vocational course with subjects English, Physics and Mathematics

- Certificate for COAFP (Children of Air Force Personnel), including certificate for children of serving/retired/deceased Air Force civilian employees paid out of defence estimates are to be downloaded as the case may be, from the download section of CASB web portal and brought along while reporting for Phase-II of the examination.
- Original Phase II admit card used during Phase-I test bearing Air Force seal and invigilator's signature.
- Original and four self-attested photocopies of HCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate (if applicable).

Note: Candidate discharged from the IAF for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

27. **Additional Skills/Qualifications/Achievements.** Candidates with any additional skills / qualifications / achievements in fields, including but not limited to, Information Technology, Motor Vehicle driving / maintenance, Hospitality, Logistics, Accounting, Catering, Welding, Typing Skills, Sports etc. are required to upload supporting certificates / documents through a link provided along with Phase-II call letter and also furnish them at the time of Phase-II testing. Candidates are encouraged to acquire additional skills to have an edge in their performance during training and subsequent tenure as Agni/veervayus.

28. **Verification of Eligibility.** Candidates should be in possession of the documents mentioned in para 26 & 27 above, when appearing for the selection test which would be scrutinised/verified prior to commencement of Phase-II to ascertain the eligibility prima-facie. Detailed verification of all the documents listed at para 26 & 27 above shall be carried out in respect of candidates who pass Adaptability Test - I. Candidates of those who do not meet the laid down educational criteria shall be cancelled during initial verification of original certificates & mark sheets and also during detailed verification at ASC.

Note-1 In the case of COAFP, the name of the candidate, parent's name and the date of birth of the candidate as mentioned in the discharge book / service book / service particular certificate (as applicable) must be the same as mentioned in the matriculation passing certificate of the candidate.

Note-2 Under no circumstances, the candidates shall be permitted to appear in Phase-II of the selection test without original educational marks sheet/passing certificates & documents mentioned above in paragraph 26. However, candidates with photocopies of educational marks sheet/passing certificates may be permitted to appear in the selection test only on production of a certificate from college/school/principal certifying that educational certificates/mark sheets are deposited with counterpart. In exceptional circumstances, Digitally signed verified certificates will be accepted and candidates will be issued with CSV (Certificate Subject to Verification) status. Candidates are thereafter required to submit original certificates to nearest ASC within one month from date of issue of CSV, to clear the CSV status.

Note-3 The original passing certificates/mark sheets shall not be retained by the selection centre. The same shall be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

Note-4 Internet copy of mark-sheet not acceptable.

Note-5 Candidates are strictly prohibited from doing any rough work or write anything anywhere on the Admit Cards issued for Phase I and Phase-II. Such candidates will be DEBARRED PERMANENTLY.

29. **Physical Fitness Test (PFT).** Names of the shortlisted candidates, who qualify the online test, shall be displayed on the CASB Web Portal <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in> and on a stipulated date shall be called at designated ASC for Physical Fitness Test (PFT), Adaptability Test I and Adaptability Test II. PFT consists of two parts, PFT-I and PFT-II.

PFT-I Candidates have to complete 1.6 Kms run as per the following timings to qualify for PFT II -

Test	Maximum permissible time	
	Male Candidates	Female Candidates
1.6 Km run	Within 07 minutes	Within 08 minutes

PFT-II Candidates who qualify PFT-I will go for PFT-II after 10 minutes of recuperation time. The sequence of exercises and maximum time period for male and female candidates are as follows -

#### MALE CANDIDATE

Test	Max Time Period	Remarks
10 Push-ups	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run
10 Sit ups	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Push-ups
20 Squats	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Sit ups

#### FEMALE CANDIDATE

Test	Max Time Period	Remarks
10 Sit ups	01 minute and 30 seconds	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run
15 Squats	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Sit-ups

Note: Candidates are advised to bring their sports shoes and short/track pants. Detailed procedure on expected technique for Push-ups, Sit-ups and Squats is published on CASB Web Portal <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in>

30. Candidates shall sign a consent form prior to appearing in physical fitness test/medical test for selection in IAF. He / She shall appear in these tests at his / her own risk and shall not be paid any compensation by IAF for injury/accident if any, sustained by him / her during such tests. The consent form shall be signed by parent/guardian of candidates below 18 years of age. The consent form is apporind with Phase-II admit card.

31. **Adaptability Test-I** All candidates who pass the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-I (objective type within 1st) which is to assess suitability of a candidate for employment in the IAF which involves deployment in varied geographic terrain, weather and operational conditions.

32. **Adaptability Test-II** All candidates who pass Adaptability Test-I shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-II as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

#### Phase-III

33. **Medical Examination** Candidates who qualify Adaptability Test II shall be issued with medical appointment letter at respective ASCs. Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject issue. Medical examination would also include the following Baseline Investigations -

- Blood Haemogram - Hb, TLC, DLC
- Urine R/E/M/E
- Biochemistry
  - Blood Sugar Fasting & PP
  - Serum Cholesterol
  - Urea, Uric Acid, Creatinine
  - LFT - Serum Bilirubin, SGOT, SGPT
- X-Ray chest (PA view)
- Ultrasonography of lower abdomen & Pelvis (For female candidates only)
- ECG (R)
- Any other test necessary in the opinion of the Medical Officer.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in Government Treasury (PDSB) through Electronic Military Receivable Order (e-MRO) / Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO / MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three working days of medical examination.

31. The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review about the appeal medical board.

Note-1 Candidates are advised to get locker and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the Medical Examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical examination for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TADA shall be admissible.

Note-2 Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in the Indian Air Force.

Note-3 Request for change of Medical Examination Centre or Date of Medical Examination shall not be entertained.

#### HOW TO APPLY

35. Candidates are to fill ONLINE Applications by logging on to <https://agni2024.casb.gov.in>

36. During online registration, the following documents are to be uploaded as applicable by respective candidates -

- Class 10<sup>th</sup> / Articulation passing certificate.
- Intermediate/10+2 or equivalent mark sheet
- Higher education Qualification/Additional skill certificates, if any.

#### OR

- 3 Yrs Engineering Diploma Final Year Mark sheet (if applying on the basis of 3 Yrs Engineering Diploma from a Govt. recognised polytechnic in prescribed stream) and Intermediate/Matriculation mark sheet (if English is not a subject in Diploma Course)

#### OR

- 2 Yrs Vocational course mark sheet of non-vocational course with subjects English, Physics and Mathematics

(d) Passport size recent colour photograph (taken not before June 2023) of size 10 KB to 50 KB (front portrait in light background without head gear except for Sikh). The photograph is to be taken with candidate holding a blank slate in front of his/her chest with his/her name and date of photograph taken, clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters. Change in appearance like goggles board head gear etc., in comparison to the photograph may result in cancellation of candidature for STAR online examination and Phase-II.

(e) Candidate's left hand thumb impression image (Size 10 KB to 50 KB)

(f) Candidate's signature image (Size 10 KB to 50 KB)

(g) Candidate's parent's (Father/Mother) / Guardian's signature image (if candidate is below 18 years on the date of filling the online application)

37. **Examination Fee:** Examination fee of Rs. 250/- is to be paid online by the candidate while registering for the online examination. The payment can be made by Debit Card/ Credit Card/netbanking/ Banking through payment gateway. Candidates are advised to follow the instructions given on the payment gateway, and also print/keep transaction details for their records.

38. **Refund of multiple payments:** If multiple payments are received from a candidate against single application, then that will be refunded back to the originating account after closing of registration and re-conflation of all payment records. However, if candidate is found to have filed multiple applications, only one application will be accepted and the amount with respect to other applications not considered for recruitment process will not be refunded. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances and shall not be kept in reserve for any other examination or selection.

39. Candidate must have fresh valid E-mail ID and Mobile No. for successful online registration.

40. Candidate should enter AADHAAR number in on-line application. Candidates from J&K, Assam and Meghalaya are exempted for the same, if not having AADHAAR card.

41. Candidates are to reach at the examination Centre with colour print out of provisional admit card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in the online test in case anomalies / irregularities/incomplete information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process.

42. The candidates should carry their AADHAAR Card (as displayed on their Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test (Phase-I & II) and Medical Test. Candidates from J&K, Assam and Meghalaya are to carry any other valid ID Proof, if not having AADHAAR Card.

- REQUESTS FOR CHANGE OF EXAMINATION CENTRE OR DATE OF SELECTION TEST SHALL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.
- Candidates not reporting for the test on due date and time shall not be accommodated on other dates/shifts.
- Duplicate / Incomplete / erroneously filled applications shall be rejected.
- Candidates should be prepared to stay for the entire duration of the tests under their own arrangement. No TADA shall be admissible.
- Candidates are required to provide an active e-mail ID which will be used by CASB for all communications till culmination of the entire selection process and enrolment for the particular intake. It is also advised to preserve e-mail ID and password for all future communications.

This Above examination methodology has been designed to Uniform selection process based on qualifications of candidates irrespective of the examination methodology. AGNIVEERYAYU decided to assign entry to be assigned any entry in the advertisement as per the intention of the Government.

24. Marks scored by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Test will be 'Normalised' by using the formula as published on the web site of the Ministry of Defence. To take into account variation in difficulty level of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to take note of the application of COAF for all shortlisted candidates for STAR Phase II Test and preparation of Final Merit List for selection will be based on 'Normalised Marks' and not on the 'Actual Marks' scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I Test. Further, in exceptional cases based on 'Normalised Marks' and not on the 'Actual Marks' scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I Test, and more than 100 marks of total marks included in exceptional cases.

25. CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER INDIVIDUALLY IN SCIENCE SUBJECTS AND OTHER THAN SCIENCE SUBJECTS, with normalised marks. **PHASE II**

26. Soon after the declaration of the result of Phase-I (Online) Test, a cut-off will be applied based on the normalised marks scored by the candidates in the Phase-I Test and SHORTLISTED candidates will be sent a new admit card on their registered e-mail ID for Phase-II Test at a designated ASC. This admit card for Phase-II exam can be downloaded online under candidates' login on CASB web portal <http://casb.gov.in>. Candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase-II at the designated ASC along with following documents:-

- (a) Colour print out of Phase-II admit card
- (b) Colour print out of duly filled application form downloaded on completion of online registration
- (c) H3 pencil, eraser, sharpener, glue stick, staples and bubble/bubble bar position for writing
- (d) Eight copies of an un-augmented passport size colour photograph (which was used for the online application registration).
- (e) Original and four self-attested photocopies of matriculation passing certificate (required for verification of candidate's name, father's name and his/her date of birth)

- (i) Original Phase-I admit card used during Phase-I test bearing Air Force seal and Inspector's signature
- (j) Original and four self-attested photocopies of NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate (if applicable)

Note: Candidate discharged from the IAF for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

27. Additional Skills/Qualifications/Achievements: Candidates with any additional skills/qualifications/achievements in fields, including but not limited to, Information Technology, Motor Vehicle driving / maintenance, Hospitality, Logistics, Accounting, Catering, Welding, Typing Skill, Sports etc. are required to upload supporting certificates/documents through admit card along with Phase-II admit card and also furnish them at the time of Phase-II test. Candidates are encouraged to acquire additional skills to have an edge in their performance during training and subsequent tenure as Agniveer/Yayu.

28. Verification of Eligibility: Candidates should be in possession of the documents mentioned at para 26 & 27 above, when appearing for the selection test which would be scrutinised/verified prior to commencement of Phase-II to ascertain the eligibility prima-facie. Detailed verification of all the documents listed at para 26 & 27 above shall be carried out in respect of candidates who pass Adaptability Test - I. Candidates of those who do not meet the laid down educational criteria shall be cancelled during initial verification of original certificates & mark sheets and also during detailed verification at ASC.

Note: 1. In the case of COAFP, the name of the candidate, parent's name and the date of birth of the candidate as mentioned in the discharge book / service book / service particular certificate / casualty certificate (as applicable) must be the same as mentioned in the matriculation passing certificate of the candidate.

Note: 2. Under no circumstances, the candidates shall be permitted to appear in Phase-II of the selection test with original educational marks sheets/passing certificates & documents mentioned above in paragraph 26. Physical Fitness Test (PFT): Names of the shortlisted candidates, who qualify the online test, shall be displayed on the CASB Web Portal (<http://casb.gov.in>) and on a stipulated date shall be called at designated ASC for Physical Fitness Test (PFT), Adaptability Test (AT) and Eligibility Test - I. PFT consists of two parts, PFT-I and PFT-II.

PFT-I: Candidates have to complete 1.6 kms run as per the following timings to qualify for PFT-II:-

PFT-II: Candidates who qualify PFT-I with 80% for PFT-II after 10 minutes of recuperation time. The sequence of exercises and maximum time period for male and female candidates are as follows:-

10 Push-ups	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run
10 Squats	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Push-ups
20 Sit-ups	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Sit-ups

Test	Max Time Period	Remarks
10 Sit-ups	01 minute and 20 seconds	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run
15 Squats	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Sit-ups

Note: Candidates are advised to bring their sports shoes and shorts/track pants. Detailed procedure on expected technique for Push-ups, Sit-ups and Squats is published on CASB Web Portal (<http://casb.gov.in>).

30. Candidates shall sign a consent form prior to appearing in physical fitness test/medical test for selection in IAF. He / She shall appear in these tests at his / her own risk and shall not be paid any compensation by IAF for injury/accident if any, sustained by him / her during such tests. The consent form shall be signed by parent/guardian of candidates below 18 years of age. The consent form is appended with Phase II admit card.

31. Adaptability Test I: All candidates who pass the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-I (a cognitive type written test) which is an assess suitability of a candidate for employment in the IAF at an hives deployment in varied geographic terrain, weather and operational conditions.

32. Adaptability Test-II: All candidates who pass Adaptability Test-I shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-II as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

33. Medical Examination: Candidates who qualify Adaptability Test-II shall be issued with medical appointment letter at respective ASCs. Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject issue. Medical examination shall also include the following Before Inventory:-

- (a) Blood Haemogram - Hb, TLC, DLC
- (b) Urine R/M/E
- (c) Biochemistry
  - (i) Blood Sugar Fasting & PP
  - (ii) Serum Cholesterol
  - (iii) Urea, Uric acid, Creatinine
  - (iv) LFT - Serum Bilirubin, SGOT, SGPT
- (d) X-Ray chest (PA view)
- (e) Ultrasonography of lower abdomen & Pelvis (For female candidates only)
- (f) ECG (R)
- (g) Any other test necessary in the opinion of the Medical Officer.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their witness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury Receipt (TR) through Electronic Military Remittance Order (e-MRO) / Military Remittance Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO / MRO, photocopy of Urine/Before Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three working days of medical examination.

34. The recruiting medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final arbiters on declaring a candidate fit during initial medical examination. Appeal medical board for medical examination prior to recruitment. The candidates shall be pointed by Armed Forces standards which may be at various normal standards. There is no provision for representation to review after the appeal medical board.

Note 1: Candidates are advised to get their hair shaven / trimmed / cut on the date of their reporting for the Medical Examination. Candidates should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical examination for two to five days under their own management. The TADA shall be inoperative.

Note 2: Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in the Indian Air Force.

36. During online registration, the following documents are to be uploaded as applicable by the respective candidates:-

- (b) Intermediate/10+2 or equivalent mark sheet
- (c) Higher Education Qualification/Additional Certificate, if any

OR

3 Yrs Engineering Diploma Final Year Mark sheet (if applying on the basis of 3 Yrs Engineering Diploma from a Govt. recognised polytechnic in prescribed stream) and Intermediate/Qualification mark sheet (if English is not a subject in Diploma Course)

OR

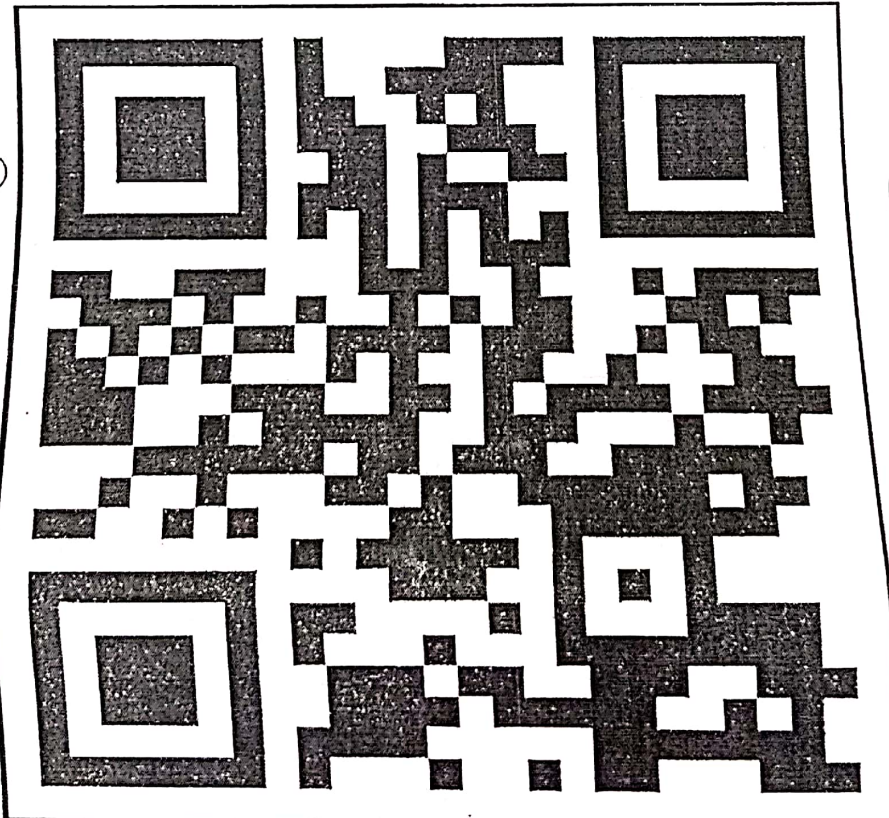
